
reflected in the waters of Llyn Mawr.



decorative shrubbery, ponds and roadways that follow the natural sweep of the terrain. "In fact", explains Griswold, "roads in the new section were placed so that some of the larger trees and existing wooded areas were preserved. These serve as a backdrop for the new memorial grounds."

Included in the new section are single and large family lots, as well as lots that will accommodate private mausoleums. Families wishing to purchase in the new area may do so by calling the office to schedule an appointment.
